

Update. FIA WEC Schedule Change and Driver Announcement



Previously listed as TBC, D'station Racing announces their Silver Driver for the FIA World Endurance Championship and the 89th Edition of the 24 Hours of Le Mans to be Andrew Watson from the United Kingdom.

Watson trained in the Junior Driver Program with Aston Martin Racing. Watson is an experienced driver at his young age, having driven in the FIA WEC and the 24 Hours of Le Mans in the 2019-2020 season. His resume also includes experience driving in major endurance races such as the Daytona 24 Hours, Spa 24 Hours, and Bathurst 12 Hours.

As you may already know, due to the COVID-19 global pandemic and travel restrictions, the 89th edition of the 24 Hours of Le Mans has been rescheduled in an attempt to potentially allow spectators by scheduling it for a later date. Additionally, the opening race for the WEC in Portimao (Portugal) will also be rescheduled. The opening race for the WEC will now be in Spa (Belgium) on May 1st.

Along with Satoshi Hoshino and Tomonobu Fujii, Andrew Watson will complete the trio of drivers who will compete in all 6 races of the World Endurance Championship.
