

Entry Announcement: "2023 Asian Le Mans Series"



D'station Racing announces its entry to compete in the 2023 Asian Le Mans Series, scheduled for February 11-12 at the Dubai Autodrome and February 18-19 at the Yas Marina Circuit in Abu Dhabi.

The Automobile Club de l'Ouest, organizers of the FIA World Endurance Championship and the 24 Hours of Le Mans, brings the Asian series back to the United Arab Emirates in its 4-race format, which started in the 2021 season. The series will bring multiple top tier racing teams from across Europe and Asia to compete for coveted invitational entries to the 24 Hours of Le Mans.

D'station Racing made its debut in the series in the 2019-2020 season, which was highlighted by their victory in the Shanghai round. Coming into its fourth consecutive season, D' station Racing will bring back a familiar driver line-up for fans of the 2022 FIA World Endurance Championship: Satoshi Hoshino (Bronze), Tomonobu Fujii (Gold), and Charlie Fagg (Silver).

D'station Racing will be supported by its Japanese staff alongside technical support from TF Sport of the United Kingdom to run the Aston Martin Vantage GT3.
