

## Entry Announcement: "2023 GT World Challenge Asia Japan Cup"



D'station Racing will continue its entry into the GT World Challenge Asia Japan Cup in 2023 with the Aston Martin Vantage AMR GT3.

The GT World Challenge Series held internationally across Europe, America, and Australia is organized by the SRO Motorsports Group. In 2022, the series brought six rounds to Asia, four of which were held in Japan as part of the Japan Cup. In the 2022 season, D'station Racing took two overall victories at the Sugo and Okayama rounds, culminating in 2nd in the GT3 Japan Cup Overall and GT3 Japan Cup PRO-AM classes.

The 2023 season will bring back driver duo Satoshi Hoshino and Tomonobu Fujii to compete in the GT3 PRO-AM class.
