

D'station Racing enters Asian Le Mans Series 2019-2020



D'station Racing has confirmed to enter Asian Le Mans Series for 2019-2020 with the Aston Martin Vantage AMR GT3 starting in the end of November.

The driver line-up is Satoshi Hoshino as the team owner, Ross Gunn - factory driver from Aston Martin Racing, and Tomonobu Fujii from SuperGT. D'station Racing will compete all four races of the series teamed up with an engineer and a mechanic from Aston Martin Racing.

The target is to get an entry for 24 Hours of Le Mans, and the team is considering other WEC races.
