

Entry Announcement: Le Mans Virtual Series 2022-23



D'station Racing will be competing in the 2022-23 season of the Le Mans Virtual Series, the world's top tier SIM racing series on the rFactor 2 platform. It is overseen by the ACO and FIA, the very same organizers involved with the 24 Hours of Le Mans and World Endurance Championship.

With its second season entry into the LMVS in sight, D'station Racing held an international driving selection process in July to recruit high-level SIM drivers from around the globe. After the primary screening of numerous driver applications, 12 candidates from 11 countries were invited to participate in private, online server testing involving qualifying and long-run simulations.

In the end, three SIM drivers were selected: Remi Delorme (France), Marc Veit (Germany), and returning D'station Racing LMVS team driver Toshiya Nojima (Japan) fought his way back onto the team.

Finally, as per the regulations, one FIA categorized professional racing driver will be on the driver roster once again. This season Charlie Fagg (United Kingdom), D'station Racing's silver driver, currently competing in the World Endurance Championship will join

The four drivers will begin this season's LMVS campaign this weekend, September 17th for Round 1 at the 8 Hours of Bahrain. Teams will battle over five races, culminating with the season's finale at the 24 Hours of Le MansVirtual in January.
