

Entry Announcement: "2024 FIA World Endurance Championship"



D'station Racing announces its entry for the 2024 season of the FIA World Endurance Championship in the new LMGT3 class as one of Aston Martin's manufacturer entries.

The driver line-up will include three-time World Endurance Champion, Marco Sorenson. D'station Racing's driver line-up will be completed by a bronze and silver driver, who will be announced at a later date.

Additionally, Tomonobu Fujii, WEC driver and Team Managing Director from the 2021-23 seasons, will now focus on team operations and lead the WEC program along with Aston Martin Racing, which will be the new base for D'station Racing's WEC project in the UK.

Competing in the FIA World Endurance Championship and the 24 Hours of Le Mans over the last three years has been the team's goal since its establishment and it was highlighted with a 2nd place podium finish in Bahrain, the team's best WEC result in the final LMGT3 race.

D'station Racing, notably the only LMGT3 entrant from Asia, will continue to challenge the world stage as an independent, international team.
