While several races ended without points, the season provided valuable lessons and a clear foundation for further progress.

Heading into 2026, D'station Racing is focused on building a consistently competitive package capable of fighting at the front across the entire season. The team will continue to campaign the Aston Martin Vantage AMR GT3 Evo, running on Dunlop tyres.

The driver line-up remains unchanged for a third consecutive year, with Tomonobu Fujii and Charlie Fagg continuing as the team's driving pairing.
