

## Entry Announcement: SuperTaikyū 2026

D'station Racing has announced its entry structure for the 2026 SuperTaikyū Series, competing with a two car programme in the ST-X and ST-1 classes.

In the ST-X class, the team will introduce the latest FIA GT3 specification Ferrari 296 GT3 Evo. The car will be driven by Satoshi Hoshino, Tomonobu Fujii and Yuta Kamimura as the team targets overall class victories throughout the season.

In the ST-1 class, D'station Racing will continue with its championship-winning line-up from the 2025 season. The team will campaign the Porsche 911 GT3 Cup (Type 992), with Tatsuya Hoshino, Tetsuya Tanaka, Kenji Hama and Taiga Kabaki sharing driving duties.

Following a brand renewal of the team's parent company, the NEXUS Group, D'station Racing will feature the NEXUS Group's new logo beginning in 2026.

With renewed motivation, the team aims to challenge for championship titles in both classes.
